

## **FEDERATION OF BATH RESIDENTS' ASSOCIATIONS**

Minutes of the Committee meeting of 11 November held on Zoom at 6.30 pm

There was a total of 28 people present

The Chair welcomed everyone. Apologies had been received from Neil Barnes, Patricia Fosbury, Stephen Little, Ian Gadd and Charles Draper.

1. Minutes. The minutes of the previous meeting and AGM on 13 September 2021, which were on the website were approved.
2. Transport Group Report. The Group's report was discussed as were issues concerning the reopening of Cleveland Bridge.
3. LTN'S. The Chair noted that the roll-out of these had been delayed but it was hoped that the Council would soon be updating residents on these and when residents would be able to be involved in the design of these.
4. Speeding. There was a lively discussion about what could be done about speeding which seems to be endemic across Bath. It was agreed that community speed watches were an important mechanism with which to help tackle this.
5. Planning Group Report. There was a brief discussion about this report which was felt to be comprehensive.
6. Entry Hill. The Committee was updated by Entry Hill's representative about latest developments and how it was expected things would develop over the short to medium term.
7. Business Group. The Committee was updated about latest developments in the city. It was noted that FOBRA had still not been recognised as a stakeholder on the city's business recovery board.
8. City Council. It was agreed that FOBRA should actively campaign for a City Council rather than some form of parish council.
