Minutes of the Committee meeting of 17 March 2022 held on Zoom at 6.00 pm

There was a total of 27 people present

The Chair welcomed everyone. Apologies had been received from Patrick Rotheram, Stephen Little, Nick Tobin and Katina Beck.

1. Minutes. The minutes of the previous meeting on 13 January 2022, which were on the website were approved.
2. Transport Group Report. The Group's report was discussed as were issues concerning the reopening of Cleveland Bridge.
3. LTN'S. There was a discussion about progress with these. The roll-out of these was sluggish but it appeared to be the case the Council would soon be engaging with residents on these and the co-design of them.
4. Planning Group Report. There was a brief discussion about this report which was felt to be comprehensive.
5. Entry Hill. The Committee was updated about latest developments at Entry Hill.
6. High Common. The Committee was updated about latest developments concerning plans for golf provision at the High Common.
7. Business Group. Rachel Hushon offered to take over as Lead for this Group and amongst other things, raise again with the Council our request that FOBRA be added as a stakeholder on the Business Recovery board.
8. City Council. The first meeting of the steering committee had taken place and a letter had been written by the Chair to BANES CEO requesting that a community governance review be carried by the Council to ascertain the desire amongst residents of the city for the restoration of our City Council.
9. AOB. The next meeting and AGM are fixed for 12 May. A discussion took place about whether they should be held in person or on Zoom. Given that a number of representatives would not be able to attend the meeting if held in person it was agreed that it should be held on Zoom again.
